The opera follows the life of a young boy with a physical disability named Amahl and his mother as they are visited by the three wise men of the Christian Epiphany seeking shelter on their journey to see the infant Jesus. During the night, Amahl’s mother is caught stealing some of the travelers’ gold, which leads to miracles of redemption, love and forgiveness. Written for television and the NBC Opera Theatre, the show was debuted on NBC in 1951. Cost is \$15 for adults and \$10 for seniors and children. Masks are required.
