*BLESSING


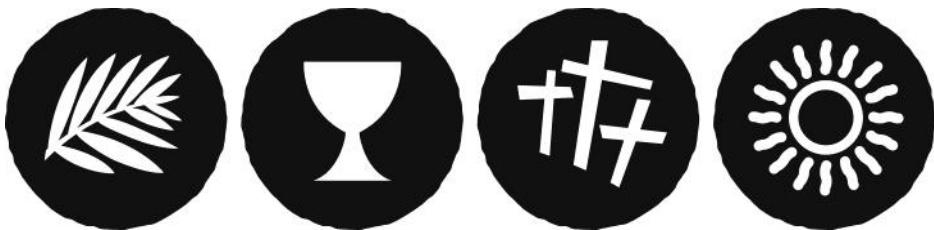
